**Subject: Request for permission to quarantine exempted international yachting customers at hotels in Chaguaramas**

Compliments of the season, Dr Parasram. We would like to thank you once again for your assistance and approval of our proposal for the safe reopening of the yacht services industry in Trinidad and Tobago. Following your approval we have reached out to the relevant authorities at the Ministry of Health, Ministry of Trade & Industry, Ministry of National Security, and the Office of the Prime Minister seeking to acquire exemptions for our international customers to enter the country.

Pending the approval from these authorities to allow foreign yachting customers entry there is a need for convenient and accessible quarantine facilities.

We are writing to inquire as to the procedure and any requirements for qualifying the hotel facilities in Chaguaramas to be used for quarantine purposes. The Bight Hotel at Peake Yacht Services and the Coral Cove Marina Hotel have offered their 10 and 14 rooms respectively for this purpose. These hotels are easily cordoned and all housekeeping staff would be compliant and professional with any and all necessary safety measures.
